**GIUGGILO VINO BIANCO IGT**

A refreshing blend of equal parts of Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Incrocio Manzoni (a cross between Riesling and Pinot Blanc). *Giuggiolo Bianco has a faint straw color with light greenish tints, and wonderfully ripe citrus aromas intermixed with grapefruit. With fine balance, vibrant fruit and a clean, crisp finish, this medium-bodied wine is particularly well-suited to spicy foods as well as a broad selection of appetizers and seafood.*

**GIUGGILO VINO ROSSO IGT**

Produced entirely from the Sangiovese clone Prugnolo Gentile. *Giuggiolo Rosso exhibits red fruit, licorice and violet aromas, an intense ruby red color that coats the glass, and a soft, velvety mouthfeel... an exceptional complement to young sharp cheeses and salami!*

**ROSSO DI MONTEPULCIANO**

95% Sangiovese and 5% Colorino aged 10 months in medium-toast French oak. *"Clean-cut red, with berry, flower and cedar on the nose and palate. Medium-bodied, with a clean, lightly spiced finish." (Wine Spectator)*

**VINO NOBILE DI MONTEPULCIANO**

80% Prugnolo Gentile, 10% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon aged 18 months in French Allier oak. Amazing, deeply resonant wine with outstanding character, this is the Vino Nobile benchmark. It is unlikely that any winery in Montepulciano is operating anywhere near the viticultural standards embraced by Corte alla Flora.

**CORTE ALLA FLORA IGT**

A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (50%), Prugnolo Gentile (30%), and 10% each Syrah and Merlot. *"Aromas of bright fruit and spices, with hints of meat. Full-bodied, with fine tannins and lots of fresh fruit. Long and caressing. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah and Sangiovese. Best after 2009. 270 cases made." (Wine Spectator)*
