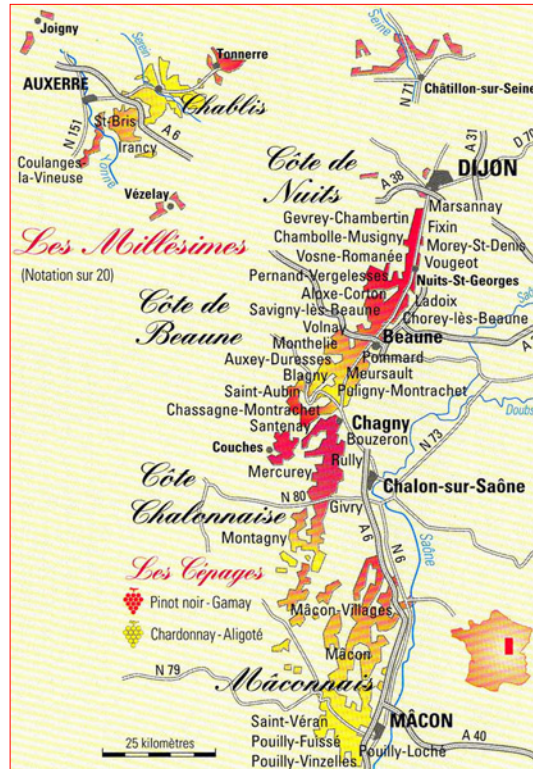




## OUTSTANDING WHITE BURGUNDY VALUE



# DOMAINE TALMARD

MÂCON • BURGUNDY

Located in the south of Burgundy between Côte Chalonnais to the north and Beaujolais to the immediate south, Mâcon is a celebrated source of fine, relatively inexpensive Chardonnay resembling the more dearly-priced Côte d'Or bottlings to the north. Domaine Talmard's Mâcon-Chardonnay vineyard is in the town of Chardonnay, considered the origin of the varietal name and one of 43 Mâcon towns allowed as suffix to Mâcon-Villages as the appellation's highest quality designation.

Continuing their family's four-century history of grape-growing in Chardonnay, father and son Gerald and Philibert Talmard own and operate the 20-hectare Domaine Talmard. Talmard soils are clay-calcareous, imparting a mineral characteristic as a welcome bracing foil to the fruity aromas of the varietal. The estate harvests at absolute physiological ripeness, retaining acidity that brings balance while preserving fruit character and a vibrant aromatic profile. Since the other growers in Chardonnay sell their grapes to the local cooperative, **this is the only estate-bottled wine from the town of Chardonnay!**

*Fermented and aged in stainless, Domaine Talmard Mâcon-Chardonnay offers outstanding freshness and a concentrated core of ripe and pure Chardonnay fruit. The aromatic and palate profiles will be strikingly familiar to fans of more expensive Burgundy appellations to the North... an outstanding white Burgundy value!*
