In Castelnuovo Abate on the south side of the Brunello di Montalcino production area, La Fiorita's growing area is made up of two separate vineyards. Poggio al Sole, at 3.5 Ha, faces south at an altitude of 600 feet above sea level. At a 900' elevation, the second vineyard, Pian Bossolino, enjoys exceptional east-south-west exposure; a hill on the north side protects the vines from cold winter winds. With Pian Bossolino's 5 Ha, the total estate vineyards make up 8.5 Ha, or about 21 acres.

LAURUS

A blend of Sangiovese (80%) and Merlot grown around the village of Montalcino; hand-harvested from 12–35 year-old vines, the wine sees 12 months in French oak barrels previously used for the estate's Brunello di Montalcino. A richly-textured Tuscan red with impressive fruit concentration and outstanding depth... every Italian wine lover needs to try this startling Tuscan value!

Wonderfully rich and approachably supple, Laurus offers pronounced flavors of spice and cherries with a hint of truffles on the finish... a formidable yet immanently drinkable red wine value from Italy's most heralded region.

Only produced in outstanding vintages from carefully selected grapes; typically aged in barrel for 2 years and then aged in bottle 2-5 years prior to release. An important, regally-scaled, powerful yet impressively sophisticated Brunello.
