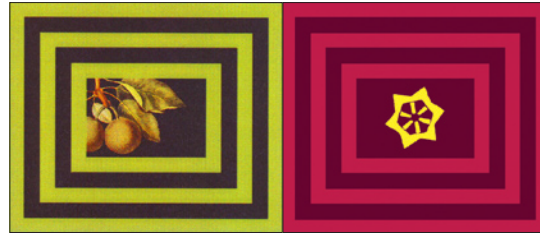

I Perazzi & Aragone

In 2001, **Lidia Bastianich**, **Joe Bastianich** and **Mario Batali** joined forces to create La Mozza, a 100-acre property located in the **Maremma** region of Tuscany approximately 45 minutes southwest of Montalcino and about 10 miles from the Tyrrhenian sea. Unlike other Tuscan regions which are often bound to severe varietal and stylistic restrictions, Maremma allows great freedom of expression. La Mozza's objective of producing unique, great wine centers on incorporating Mediterranean varietals such as **Alicante**, **Carignan** and **Syrah** into the region's **Morellino**-based tradition.

I PERAZZI MORELLINO DI SCANSANO

Named for the trees that grow on the estate and yield pear-like fruits, I Perazzi anticipates an exciting vinicultural future for this previously-conservative region.

Parker's Wine Advocate: 88 POINTS "The 2009 Morellino di Scansano I Perazzi is a tasty, vibrant red bursting with sweet dark cherries, flowers, spices and minerals. This is a decidedly fresh style for the Perazzi with excellent length and fine overall balance."

LA MOZZA ARAGONE

Aragone is named for Spain's royal family who conquered Maremma in 1447 and dominated the region during the Renaissance. The six-pointed star symbol on the label recalls Forte Stella, a star-shaped fort built by Cosimo de Medici in the 16th century to protect Porto Ercole.

Parker's Wine Advocate: 92 POINTS "The 2007 Aragone is a blend of Sangiovese, Alicante, Syrah and Carignano. Racy dark red cherries, flowers, earthiness and licorice are some of the nuances that flow from this textured, expressive wine. In 2007, Aragone sits on the razor's edge of over ripeness; coming close, but never going over the top. A refined, polished finish serves to balance some of the more opulent qualities. This racy, sexy wine delivers incredible quality for the money. Anticipated maturity: 2010-2020."
