Laurent Martray works 5 hectares of estate vineyards in Brouilly, renting an additional 5 hectares from renowned Château de la Chaize. With some of the oldest vines of the appellation, Martray crafts minuscule annual amounts of two Brouilly cuvées and a Côte de Brouilly; the estate prefers manual punchdowns during the 8-10 day fermentation, ages the wines 8-10 months in oak, and does not filter. Martray's Brouilly **Vieilles Vignes** is produced from 40-year old vines and aged in large oak foudres, while a mere 3 – 5 annual barrels of "**Cuvée Corentin**" are produced from 60-year-old vines with élevage in small French oak barrels. The exceptional Côte de Brouilly "Les Feuillées" rounds out the portfolio. Martray's wines are widely considered hallmarks of Cru Beaujolais.
