SAUVIGNON BLANC Vicar's Choice Marlborough

*Wine Spectator on the 2009: **90 POINTS*** "Bright and refreshing, generous with its melon, apricot and mineral aromas and flavors, finishing with lime and herb notes that do not quit. Drink now."

*Wine Advocate on the '08: **90 POINTS*** "The 2008 Vicar's Choice Pinot Noir displays red currant and raspberry on the nose, with good definition. Wild strawberry and crisp red cherry on the palate with very fine tannins, nice weight and poise on the feminine finish."

SAUVIGNON BLANC Pioneer Block 18 Snap Block

*Stephen Tanzer on the 2008: **90 POINTS*** "Bright pale yellow. Intriguing nose combines grapefruit pith, lemon ice and white pepper. Juicy and intense, with ripe, integrated acidity framing the citrus and fresh apple flavors. Offers good density without any sensation of weight. Finishes with noteworthy cut and length."

SAUVIGNON BLANC Wairau Valley Reserve

*Stephen Tanzer on the 2006: **91 POINTS*** "Pale, bright yellow. Pungent if tightly wound nose offers grapefruit pith, fresh pineapple, gooseberry and a light resinous quality. The grapefruit and pineapple fruit flavors are strong and high-pitched, giving this very intense wine a penetrating character rare for New Zealand sauvignon. Perhaps most impressive today on the intense, palate-cleansing finish, which features a superb whiplash of quince and pear skin flavor and a piquant peppery element."

*Parker's WA on the 2007: **91 POINTS*** "The 2007 Wairau Reserve Sauvignon Blanc is sourced from the top 1% of fruit and it shows. An elegant, apple blossom nose with white flowers and freshly cut lime with beautiful definition, the palate is well-defined, harmonious with green apple, apricot, lime and passion fruit infusing the palate with a touch of granite on the elegant finish. A superb, almost sensual Sauvignon Blanc."

PINOT NOIR Pioneer Block 4 Sawcut

PINOT NOIR Doctor's Creek Reserve

*Parker's WA on the 2006: **90 POINTS*** "Sourced from a clay-based subsoil, the 2006 Doctor Creek Reserve Pinot Noir has a backward, brooding nose, the palate with "wine gums" on the entry, a touch of bilberry and white pepper leading to a dense, masculine finish that suggests one should wait 2-3 years before opening a bottle, for it certainly has the structure to merit cellaring."

PINOT NOIR Omaka Reserve

*Wine Enthusiast on the 2005: **90 POINTS*** Editor's Choice "Saint Clair's top Pinot is gorgeous in the successful 2005 vintage, marrying oaky complexity – cedar, sandalwood and dried spices – with lush black cherry fruit. The wood and fruit are beautifully integrated, making it hard to tell where one leaves off and the other begins, and the flavors come to a long, elegant close. Drink now-2012."
