TERROIR DEL NORD Erbaluce di Caluso

Produced in the foothills of the Alps east of Turin in northern Piedmont around the towns of Caluso and Canavese, Erbaluce di Caluso achieved DOC classification status in 1967. Meaning *shining grass*, **Erbaluce** is a local grape producing distinctively spicy, aromatically complex white wines. The wines tend to be rich but bright, with floral accents and a nutty, often spicy character on the finish.

Although the region's wineries have produced Erbaluce di Caluso for over 400 years, the wine has only recently gained popularity outside Italy. Obscured to outsiders for centuries, Erbaluce has experienced a renaissance in popularity over the last five years. The few examples available stateside have fascinated American consumers and Erbaluce di Caluso will continue to grow in popularity as increased production and enhanced export heighten consumer exposure.

Terroir del Nord is the latest brainchild of Tuscany's renowned Paolo De Marchi of Isole e Olena (Chianti) and Proprietà Sperino (Piedmont).

A classic wine with intense wild flowers on the nose, savory mineral character on the palate and a long, refreshing finish. This is an excellent accompaniment to most fish entrées and a broad range of appetizers.
